BEFORE YOU START

CONTEXT! CONTEXT! CONTEXT!

1. **WHO?** *Who is writing; who were they writing to?*
2. **WHAT?** *What kind of writing is this? (The genre)*
3. **WHERE?** *Where was it written; where was it read?*
4. **WHEN?** *What time period was this written in?*
5. **WHY?** *Why was this written? (Whats the occasion?)*



Pro-tip: Get a good commentary to quickly review these basics for each book of the Bible before you begin.

AS YOU READ

USE A WHOLE PARAGRAPH TO ANSWER

1. What is the **MAIN POINT** in your own words?
2. What are individual **WORDS** that stand out?
3. What are the **CONNECTOR** words?
(therefore, but, and, as, for, because, etc)
4. How would you describe the **TONE**?
5. How is it **RELATED** to what's before & after it?
